Update on Kennelly Square Project

Kennelly Square is a 26-unit, 55-and-over resident complex, each unit is approximately 950 square feet and includes a single bedroom, a den, a living room, and a kitchen with two bathrooms. There are three floors which make up the height of the building with an elevator in the center of the building. There is an apartment on premise for the superintendent/maintenance person. The parking lot is located in the rear of the building, which will be the main entrance and exit to the building. The apartments tentatively will be ready for leasing and occupied sometime in the fall of 2023. The units are specifically offered to Clarkstown residents on a first come first serve basis. The price of these units are not known at this time.

Congers Fire

On April 14th 2023 Congers faced its largest fire in decades. We would like to thank Congers Fire Department as well as the 26 other fire departments from Rockland, Orange, Westchester and New Jersey that assisted in putting the fire out. The organized effort minimized the damage to all property. They managed to keep the fires at bay preventing them from spreading past fences and sheds.

We would also like to that the entire Clarkstown Police Department for the rapid response in assisting with the evacuation of over 100 homes. These homes consisted of young couples, families, elderly and beloved family pets. Their rapid response is greatly apricated and prevented the loss of life from the fires.

Finally, The Civic Association would like to acknowledge The Davies Family. Who provided their property for a staging area and command post for the leaders to organize and identify the best plan of attack to extinguish the fires.

As of now CSX has assumed responsibility for the fire starting, although the official cause of the fire is still pending with inspections. Several home owners that suffered damage have reported that CSX has sent out their own adjusters to evaluate damage and hope to be receiving help soon to repair and replace damaged items. We hope that this 65-billion-dollar company quickly finds the funds to restore our neighbors' homes and possessions quickly and correctly
